## December 1

Remind our children that God is merciful, compassionate, slow to anger, full of unfailing love and is eager to turn back from destroying people.

### **Divine Encounters, Great Harvest**

Like Philip, may our children be laborers who are sent at just the right moment to those whose hearts are hungry and ready to receive the gospel. May they see a great harvest of souls in their life time.

## December 7

### **Immediate Obedience**

Even when they don't know why, may our children, like Philip, be obedient to go where the Spirit leads them and do as He instruct them to do.

## December 8

### **Prepared Hearts**

As the eunuch's heart was hungry to understand and receive the truth, may our children's hearts be hungry and prepared to receive the gospel of truth when it is presented to them here in this house by our children's pastors and teachers.

### **In their Weaknesses**

May the power of God be displayed in our children's weaknesses, affirming His grace is all they need.

Remind our children that sin is no longer their master. In their struggles and failures, may they turn to God who understands. At His throne of grace, may they ask for forgiveness, receive it and move forward in victory. **Romans 6:14 NLT**

### **Demonstration of Love**

If our children feel uncertain of God's love, may they be reminded of God's demonstration of love when He sent Christ to die for them while they were still sinners. **Romans 5:8 NKJV, NLT**

## **December 19**

### **Reconciled to God**

May all of our children enter into a wonderful new relationship with God, rejoicing because the Lord Jesus Christ has reconciled them back to Him. **Romans 5:11 NKJV, NLT**

## **December 20**

### **Grace**

May God's wonderful grace rule and reign in our children's lives giving them right standing with God and eternal life through Jesus Christ. **Romans 5:21 NKJV NLT**

**Dead to Sin** As God's children, may our children consider themselves dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus. May they live for the glory of God and become all that He wants them to be.

### **A Command**

### **A Perfect Fit**

Lord, cause our children to find the place and role in God's body where they will fit perfectly to do the work You have for them. **Ephesians 4:16 NLT**

### **Old Hurts**

Throughout their lives, may our children refuse to hold on to old hurts and wounds so Satan will be denied the opportunity to gain a foothold. **Ephesians 4:27 NLT**

### **Compelled to Speak**

Like Stephen, may our children be full of God's grace and power and may they have a strong faith and bold witness that compels them to speak the truth in love. **Acts 6:8 NIV**
