



# Prayers for Children January



*There is power in agreement as the church prays the same prayer each day of the month. This agreement will create a prayer covering over our children. Will you join this church body as we cover our children and youth daily in prayer?*

## January 1

**Name of Jesus** Cause our children to call on the name of Jesus and be saved. Remind them that there is no one else and no other name under heaven by which they must be saved. **Acts 4:12 NLT, NKJV**

## January 2

**Intentional and Focused** Like Jesus, may our children routinely seek the Lord to know Him better and to gain insight for living. May their solitary quiet times with Him be focused and intentional. **Mark 1:35 NIV**

## January 3

**Revealed to the Childlike** May the Father begin revealing the hidden things to our children at an early age and may they remain childlike in spirit to receive all He has for them. **Luke 10:21 NLT**

## January 4

**According to Habit** Like Jesus who according to His habit went to the Mt. of Olives to pray, may our children find a place where they usually go to pray and may it become a habit in the rhythm of their lives. **Luke 22:39 NLT**

## January 5

**Mentioned Continually in Prayer** Lord, raise up from among us those who will constantly pray for our children. In their thankfulness for the gift of children, may they mention them continually in their prayers. **I Thessalonians 1:2 NIV, NLT**

## January 6

**Prayer and Praise** May our children praise the Lord as long as they live and may they continually lift their hands in prayer. **Psalms 63:4 NLT**

## January 7

**Inspired to Pray** Like David, may our children be inspired to pray and ask for mercy and grace in all their troubles. **Psalms 4:1 NLT**

## January 8

**Confident Prayers** Like David, may our children be confident that the Lord hears the voice of their weeping and their pleas for help. May they be confident that He will receive and answer those prayers. **Psalms 6:8, 9 NKJV, NLT**

## January 9

**Pray** As godly people, inspire our children to pray while there is still time and You may be found. **Psalms 32:6 NLT, NKJV**

## January 10

**Diligent in Prayer** May our children be lifted above their circumstances as they remain steadfast in prayer. As they continue in prayer and partnership with God, may His plans and purposes be accomplished in their lives. **Romans 12:12 c KJV**

## January 11

**Day and Night** Remind us to bring our children and their needs to God in prayer. May it be often throughout the day and night. **Romans 1:9 NLT**

## January 12

**Directly to the Father** May our children embrace the privilege of going directly to the Father and may they begin at an early age asking in the name of Jesus for all they need. **John 16:23 NLT**

## January 13

**An Attitude of Prayer** Holy Spirit, inspire our children to have regular times of prayer and may they have an attitude of prayer that causes them to pray without ceasing. **I Thessalonians 5:17 NKJV**

## January 14

**Loving and Praying** May our children overcome evil with good by loving their enemies and praying for those who persecute them. **Matthew 5:44 NLT**

## January 15

**Ordained Prayer** Lord, remind our children that even though You already know their needs before they ask, You have ordained prayer and desire them to ask in faith believing that You will answer them. May they come to You with all their needs. **Matthew 6:8 NIV**

## January 16

**The Secret Place** Jesus, inspire our children to daily go into their rooms, shut the door, and pray to the Father in private and what He sees them do in secret will be rewarded openly. **Matthew 6:6 NLT, NKJV**



## January 17

### Knows, Cares, Understands

May our children confidently pray to their heavenly Father who knows them intimately, passionately cares about them and understands them completely. **Matthew 6:9 NIV**

## January 18

### Heavenly Perspective

As our children look to their heavenly Father and pray, may their upward gaze gain them a heavenly perspective about every situation. **Matthew 6:9 NIV**

## January 19

### Unpretentious Way

As our children mature, may they pursue the spiritual discipline of fasting and do it in an unpretentious way that does not draw attention to themselves. **Matthew 6:16 NIV**

## January 20

### Spiritual Discipline

Father, as our children grow and mature, may the spiritual discipline of fasting become a private part of their Christian walk. **Matthew 6:18 NLT**

## January 21

### Private, Unseen, Changed

May fasting become a private, unseen part of our children's Christian walk that draws them closer to God and changes them from the inside out. **Matthew 6:18 NIV**

## January 22

### Delayed, Undefeated

May our children remain at peace and undefeated when their answers to prayer are delayed. May the words of Jesus spur them on to keep asking until they receive, seeking until they find and knocking until the doors are open to them. **Matthew 7:7, 8 NIV**

## January 23

### Persistent

All the days of their lives may our children persistently lay their needs before the Lord. May they hold tight to His promise that everyone who asks will receive an answer. **Matthew 7:7a, 8a NIV**

## January 24

### Number One Priority

May seeking the Lord be our children's number one priority. As they search the scriptures and seek Him in prayer, may they hold tight to the promise that in their persistence of seeking they will find what they are looking for. **Matthew 7:7b, 8b NIV**

## January 25

### Hope for Answered Prayer

May our children's hope for answered prayer be found in the character of God. Cause them to know what a loving and good Father He is and may they know He will give good gifts to His children when they ask for them. **Matthew 7:11 NIV**

## January 26

**Keep Hoping And Praying** May our children be like David; continuing to hope and pray when they feel like giving up because of seemingly hopeless situations that test their faith. **Psalms 69:13 NLT**

## January 27

### Christ Lives in Them

May all of our children be able to declare: "It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and I live by faith in God's Son who loved me and gave Himself for me." **Galatians 2:20 NKJV**

## January 28

### Adopted Children

May our children claim their full identity as God's adopted children and live in the freedom from the power of sin that Jesus provided. **Galatians 4:5 NLT**

## January 29

**Radiant Lives** May joy, peace, love and hope fill our children's lives and may it radiate from them in all they say and do. **Galatians 5:22 NIV**

## January 30

**Follow His Leading** As our children live by the Spirit, may they choose to follow His leading in every part of their lives. **Galatians 5:25 NLT**

## January 31

### Like the Smallest Seed

Father, may the small seeds of truth planted in our children's hearts at an early age grow and produce great results like that of the mustard seed which becomes the largest of plants. **Matthew 13:31, 32 NLT**
