June 1

Impact of Disobedience Urge our children to never ignore God's pursuit of them. May they be aware that their disobedience has the potential to negatively impact others or put them in harm's way. **Jonah 1:4-7 NIV**

June 7

Tool of Correction

If our children should find themselves in troubling circumstances as a result of having bad attitudes or actions, may God keep His hand on them and use their situations as a tool of correction to get them to stop running and turn to Him. **Jonah 1:17, 2:1-6 NIV**

June 8

God's Perfect Timing May our children never lose heart and trust God's perfect timing. In life's painful moments and God's seemingly slow response to their cries, may they embrace these opportunities to honor God without grumbling, complaining or blaming Him for their circumstances. **John 11:5-7 NIV**

June 9

Generously Share

May our children generously share what they have with those who are poor and in need. **Luke 3:11 NLT**

June 10

A Quiet Solitary Place

May our children go alone to a solitary place of peace and quiet to seek the Father, give Him their focus and pray. **Mark 1:35 NLT, NKJV**

Faith that Affects Others

At every opportunity and with great faith, may our children do all they can to bring their friends to Jesus and like the paralyzed man, may their friends be forgiven, saved and healed.

Selfless, Responsible

Unlike the prodigal, may our children be selfless, responsible and have moral restraint. **Luke 15:11-13 NIV**

Desperate and Humble May our children have a desperation to know Jesus that causes them to humble themselves before Him and receive His Salvation. **Luke 19:3-4 NIV**

God's Way

When our children go to Jesus for help in the situations of life, may they submit to His way of doing things and follow His plan by doing whatever He tells them to do. **John 2:5 NIV**

June 18

Protected Hearts

Father, protect our children's hearts from the love of human praise more than the praise of God. **John 12:43 NLT**

June 19

Humility

May God's desires and purposes increase in our children's hearts and may their desires decrease as they hold their plans tentatively to give way to His. **John 3:30 NKJV, NLT**

June 20

Spiritually Nourished

Like Jesus, may our children find spiritual nourishment in doing God's will and completing the work He calls them to do. **John 4:34 NLT**

June 21

Nothing Wasted

Remind our children that God can use a little to abundantly bless others and He will waste nothing. **John 6:11-13 NIV**

June 22

Confident At all times and in every situation, may our children be confident that the Holy Spirit will help them. **Philippians 1:19 NLT**

June 23

Strength in Christ

Holy Spirit, empower our children to do Your will and to face challenges. May they do all things through Christ who strengthens them. **Philippians 4:13 NKJV, NLT**

June 24

Work Attitude Jesus, remind our children to work willingly at whatever they do, as though they were working for You rather than people. **Colossians 3:23 NLT**

June 25

Live Wisely Lord, help our children to live wisely among non-believers and may they make the most of every opportunity to convey Christ. **Colossians 4:5 NLT**

June 26

Little Twists and Surprises

Even when they don't understand God's ways or decisions, may our children trust Him and may He enrich their lives with little twists and surprises they did not anticipate and could never have imagined. **Romans 11:33 NLT**

Genuine Affection

Father, show our children how to love one another with kind and genuine affection. **Romans 12:10 NLT, NKJV**
