Unlike the people of Judah, may our children be genuine, love God's Word, encourage His messengers and have the favor of the Lord upon them.

Godly Advisors

Like Ezra, may our children fear God and His commands and may they be strong, courageous and wise in His counsel. In their sphere of influence, may they become godly advisors who know the appropriate actions to take to make things right with God

Frustrated Plans May the plans and schemes of the enemy against our children be frustrated and unsuccessful.

Discipline

May our children not despise the Almighty's discipline but consider it joy to be corrected by God.

Discernment Lord, may our children see the clear distinction between good and evil; light and darkness; the bitter and the sweet. Isaiah 5:20 NLT, NKJV

Treatment of Others Urge our children to treat others fairly. Cause them to refrain from making decisions based on hearsay and may their judgments never be made on appearances only. Isaiah 11:3 NLT

May 22

Honoring God

As our children honor God with their lips, may it come from a loving, honest and sincere heart that is close to Him. Isaiah 29:13 NLT

May 23

Strength

As our children rest in the Lord, may they find strength in quietness and confidence.

May 24

Complacency During times of ease and comfort, urge our children to throw off complacency and press into God's purpose for their lives.

Weak and Weary

When our children grow weak and weary, may they turn to the One who never grows weak or weary and He will give them power in their weakness and strength when they have no strength.

Encouraged and Unafraid

May our children be encouraged and unafraid because God is with them and will help them, strengthen them and hold them up with His victorious right hand.

Focused
