Father, remind our children that steps of obedience can become miraculous blessings when they step out in faith and partner with Jesus. **John 2:7, 8 NIV**

God's Way

When our children go to Jesus for help in the situations of life, may they submit to His way of doing things and follow His plan by doing whatever He tells them to do. **John 2:5 NIV**

September 6

Obediently Submitted

As Christ's obedient servants, may our children be submitted to doing whatever He tells them to do; following all His instructions.

John 2:5, 8 NLT

September 7

Life's Sudden Storms

May our children's times of prayer and worship prepare them to weather the storms of life that come without warning. In the storm, may they rely on Jesus to rescue them.

September 8

Without Fear or Panic

When life's circumstances get stirred up like a dangerous storm, may our children cry out to Jesus. May their faith and confidence in Him cause them to sail across the storm-tossed sea without fear or panic.

Faith, Not Fear

In the storms of life, may our children respond with faith rather than fear because Jesus is with them.

September 10

Nothing Too Hard

Unlike the disciples, may our children never underestimate Jesus' power and ability to handle every situation and crisis they face. **Mark 4:41 NIV**

September 11

Not their Own Strength

May our children purpose in their hearts to call on Jesus in the midst of the storm rather than fighting it on their own strength.

September 12

Lord Over All

In the practical daily situations and storms of life, may our children remember that Jesus is Lord over everything and there is no storm too big or too fierce for Him to handle.

September 13

Always Hope, Never Give Up

Unlike the lame man, may our children never give up, always have hope and never resign themselves to being an invalid who is weak and failing. May they look to Jesus in agreement with His ability to instantly cure them. **John 5:5-8 NIV**

September 14

Expectant and Obedient

If our children should find themselves in a hopeless, helpless situation, may they expectantly look to Jesus and do what He tells them to do.

John 5:8, 14 NIV

September 15

Power to Stand and Walk Away

May our children look to Jesus for the power to stand and walk away from the hopeless situation that once imprisoned them. **John 5:8, 14 NIV**



September 16

Mat of Shackled Thinking

Father, keep our children from falling into the trap of shackled thinking that says nothing will ever change and may they never resign themselves to sitting on the mat of weakness and hopeless thinking that tries to imprison them. **John 5:6, 7 NIV**

September 17

Opportunities

On the Sabbath and from a place of rest, may our children continue to do good and bless others when the opportunity presents itself. **John 5:15-17 NLT**

September 18

Periods of Rest

While doing God's work, remind our children it is important to take time for rest and renewal in a quiet place alone. **Mark 6:30, 31 NLT**

September 19

God's Provision

When our children have seemingly impossible tasks with limited resources, remind them to thankfully bless what they have and ask God to do the rest by providing the increase. **Mark 6:41 NLT**

September 20

Kiss of Betrayal In the face of deception and betrayal, may our children be as gracious as Jesus who called Judas friend after receiving a cold, calculated and deliberate kiss of deception. **Matthew 26:49, 50 NIV**

September 21

Trust God Instead of taking matters into their own hands, may our children look to God for direction and rather than forcing the issue, may they trust God to work out His plan and purpose in the situation. **Matthew 26:51, 52 NIV**

September 22

Stay Close

If panic tries to take hold of our children like it did the disciples, may they resist the urge to run away. Instead, may they remain close and make Jesus their shelter, refuge and safe place. **Matthew 26:53, 56 NIV**

September 23

Mob Mentality Lord, protect our children's minds from the mob mentality that is motivated by feelings and experience rather than by facts and truth. May they think for themselves instead of joining the crowd. **Mark 14:43, 48, 49 NIV**

September 24

Place of Remembrance

Like the disciples at the Sea of Galilee, may our children have a place where Jesus finds them and captures their heart. May it become a place of remembrance that brings refreshing and causes them to focus on what is most important. **John 21:1 NLT**

September 25

Wait and Listen

For the important work God has for our children, may they wait and listen for His complete instructions and move forward by the power of the Holy Spirit to see it completed. **Acts 1:2, 8 NIV**

September 26

God's Timetable

May our children be patient, trusting God's timetable for their lives because He alone has the authority to set the times and the seasons of life. **Acts 1:7 NLT, NKJV**

September 27

Power to Witness

Father, may our children receive the power of the Holy Spirit to witness and work for You on this earth. **Acts 1:8 NLT**

Disappointment

Father, help our children to move on from the paralyzing trap of disappointment that causes heaviness when they think about all the what ifs, if onlys, should haves and could haves that did not happen **I Samuel 16:1 NIV**

Never Return Void

When our children boldly speak God's Word in witness or encouragement, may it accomplish more than they ever dreamed possible because His Word will not return void. **Isaiah 55:11 NIV, NKJV**
