September 1

Remind our children that lying is always a sin no matter what the attitude or motive and that God will be merciful to them when they ask for forgiveness and do their best to follow His way of life. **Joshua 2:4-5 NIV**

People of Action

Like Rahab, may our children be people of action who do exactly as the Lord leads them and may their actions lead to seeing their entire household and all their relatives being saved.

September 6

Unassuming Mindset

May our children have an unassuming mindset that says their parent's relationship with God is also mine. May they individually seek and commit their lives to the Lord for themselves. **I Samuel 2:12, 18-25 NIV**

September 7

In the Lord's Presence Like Samuel did in the presence of the Lord, may our children grow in stature and favor with God and man.

September 8

Godly Supervision

Holy Spirit, teach our children's parents how to strike proper balance between family and other responsibilities and like Samuel and unlike Eli's sons, may they submit to the Godly supervision of their parents and walk in God's ways.

September 9

When God Speaks As our children are in God's presence, may they be good listeners who hear what God speaks and may they have a servant's heart to do as He says.

Life Long Affect Like a tree of life, may the words spoken to our children by their parents be life giving. May their parents understand the lifelong affect their words carry.

Good Reputation

Father, may our children choose behavior that will give them a good reputation and may they esteem their good reputation as being more valuable than silver or gold because it honors You. **Proverbs 22:1 NLT**

Words Like Honey

Like honey, may the words our children speak be kind and sweet to the soul. May their words bring restoration and healing to the body.
