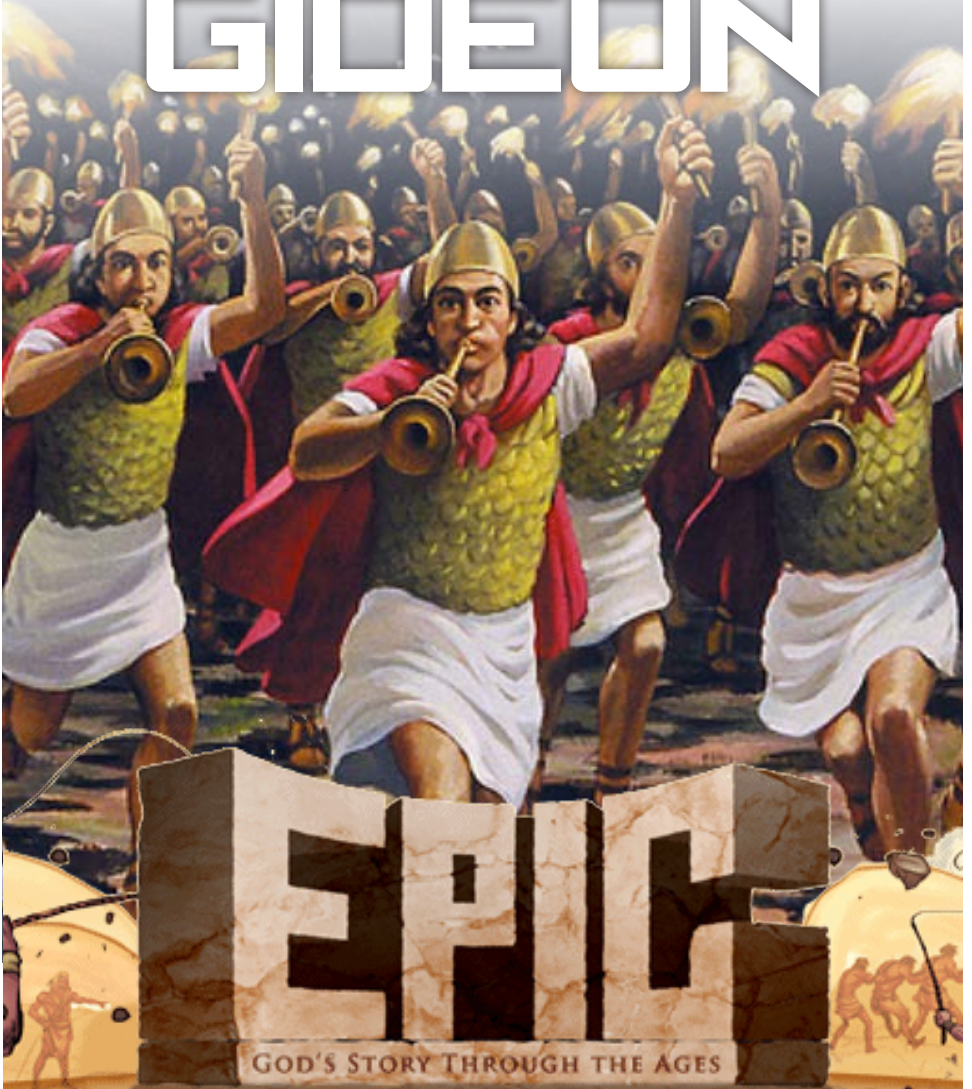

THURSDAY ____ **Judges 7:15-16** What were the weapons Gideon passed out to his men?

FRIDAY ____ **Judges 7: 17-20** What did the men shout?

SATURDAY ____ **Judges 7:21-22** How did the Midianites die?

- S U E**: Connected to **A** (S to A, U to A, E to A).
- A**: Connected to **F** (A to F).
- F**: Connected to **D** (F to D).
- D**: Connected to **G I N !** (D to I, D to N).
- G I N !**: Connected to **O** (N to O).
- O**: Connected to **L** (O to L).
- L**: Connected to **T** (L to T).
- T**: Connected to **W R** (T to W, T to R).
- W R**: Connected to **S U E** (W to S, R to U).

The path of letters is: H -> S -> U -> E -> A -> F -> D -> I -> N -> O -> L -> T -> W -> R.
