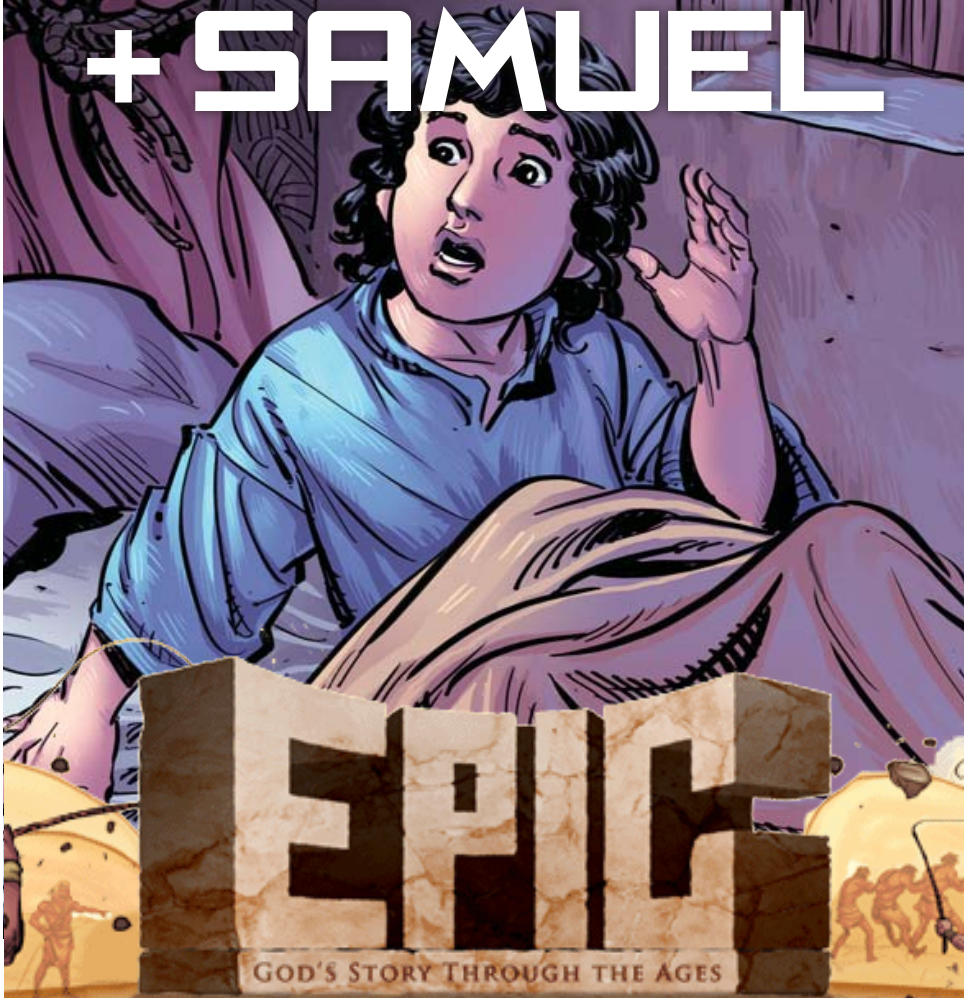

# GOD TIME
