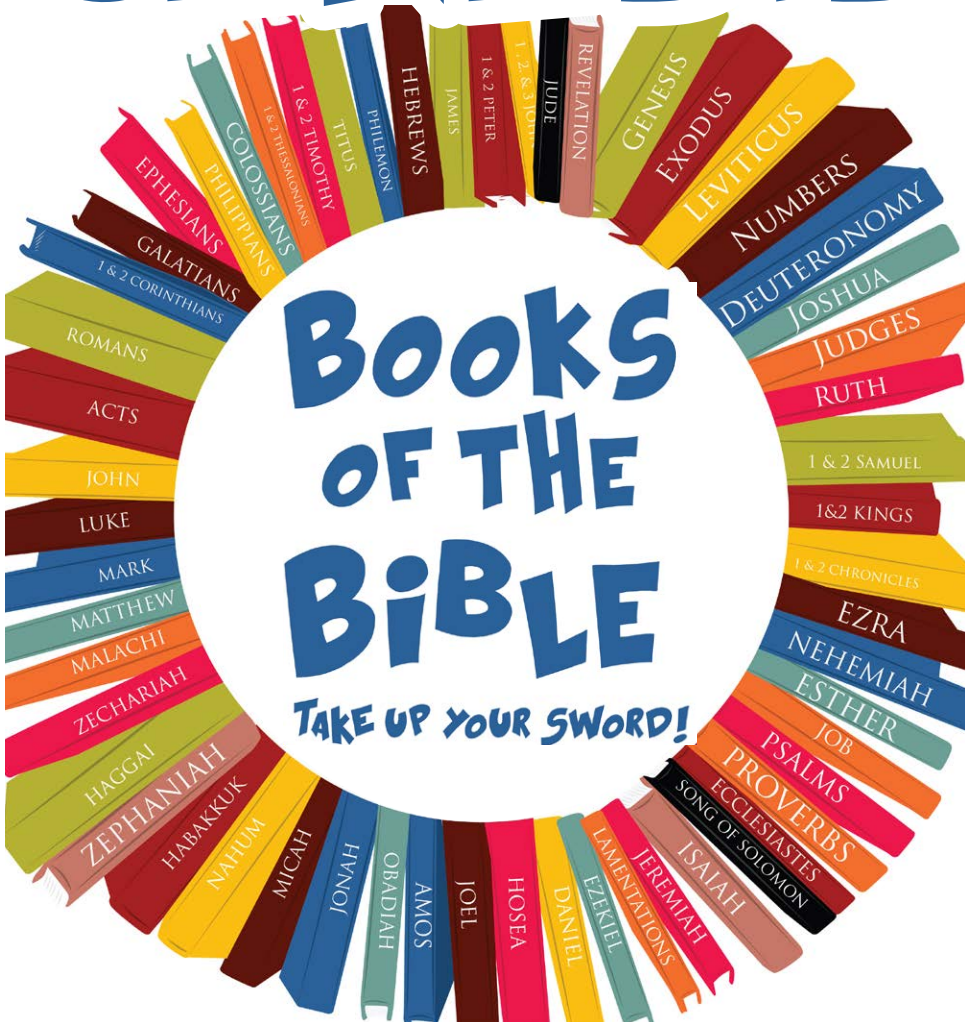

Abraham, Sarah, and Isaac



(Genesis 18:1-15; 21:1-7)

God promised to bless Abraham and build a great nation from him. But 25 years later, he still did not have the son God had promised him! Then God sent three visitors, probably angels, to renew His promise to Abraham. He welcomed them and had them sit down while he brought them food. Sarah stayed in the tent. After they ate, they gave Abraham a message from God.

Directions: Follow the directions to discover what they said and how Sarah responded. Look up Genesis 18:10, 12 to check your work. Cross out all words that are animals, numbers, and colors.
